The 4th Commandment

By the fourth commandment we are commanded to respect and love our parents, to obey them in all that is not sinful, and help them when they are in need.

This commandment also obliges us to respect and obey all our lawful superiors. Parents and superiors are required to provide for the spiritual and bodily welfare of those under their care. The fourth commandment requires of us certain duties as citizens. A citizen must love his/her country, be sincerely interested in its welfare, and respect and obey its lawful authority.

Having considered in the fourth commandment what we owe our parents for cooperating with God in giving us that great gift of life.

What are the duties of children towards their parents?

As Saint John Baptist de la Salle said.

"The 1st duty of children to their parents is to respect at them all times and on all occasions. A father and mother are, in regard to their children, the representatives of God. To fail in respect towards them is to fail in respect towards God Himself. The 2nd duty is to love them. The 3rd duty is to obey".

✠ **Cross Catholic Outreach:** Father Patrick J. McCormick of Cross Catholic Outreach will be visiting our parish the weekend of Oct 22-23rd to speak at all the Masses on behalf of the poor in developing countries.

Cross Catholic Outreach was founded to create a meaningful link between parishes in America and the priests and nuns working in the Church overseas in the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Central and South America.



Father Patrick J. McCormick, born and raised in Erie, PA, was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Atlanta in December 1968.

He served in five parishes in Atlanta, and was on the faculty of the North American College in Rome for four years before entering on active duty as a chaplain in the United States Navy in 1990. While

on active duty, he was stationed aboard two aircraft carriers, served three years in Italy, five years in Japan, and a year and a half in Afghanistan. After retiring from the Navy he served for three years as a civilian priest for the Air Force at Tyndall Air Force Base.

In 2013, Father McCormick joined Cross Catholic Outreach to use his gifts and talents to help the poorest of the poor!
